The National Stalking Training Academy was launched in March 2011 and is a culmination of over two years of international research to meet the needs of victims and organisations.

The first course to be launched from the National Academy is; **Understanding and Responding to Stalking.**

This course is designed to provide an overview of stalking to all organisations or individuals who deal with or have a duty of care to those who are either affected by or at risk from stalking.

Delegates will gain an understanding and skills to build or improve on how to reduce the overt, underlying and reactive issues that stalking causes.

The Academy has for the first time brought together some of the world's leading experts in this field from law, psychiatry, practitioners and victims themselves to develop a range of education and other services to professionalise and codify effective best practice from existing knowledge and practice throughout the UK.
